

2008 Wilcox Area Chamber of Commerce Crappie Jackpot Derby – Official Rules

- The Jackpot Crappie Derby will begin at 5:00 AM CST, April 19, 2008 and end at 11:59PM CST on May 18, 2008. These are hereby referred to as the "Official Derby Hours." To claim a prize for the catch of a tagged fish, the fish must be caught during Official Derby Hours and presented to Derby officials prior to 11:59 PM CST on May 18, 2008.
- Participant must purchase a \$5 entry ticket prior to catching a tagged fish.
- Tagged fish must be caught on a hook and line. Hoop nets, gill nets, seines, or fish baskets are prohibited means to catch a tagged fish. Fish must be presented alive in order to be eligible.
- Participants must comply with all Federal, State, County, and City Laws, Rules and Regulations.
- Officially tagged fish are labeled with readily identifiable tags including the event name, tag number, and phone number to report the catch.
- To claim a prize, an angler must first purchase a \$5 entry ticket, catch a tagged fish using hook and line and without the aid of a net larger than a dip net, present the tagged fish alive to tournament officials within Official Derby Hours, and pass a polygraph or voice stress test assuring that all Derby rules stated on this form have been adhered to. Anglers failing to pass a polygraph or voice stress test will be barred from collecting prize money.
- The fish tagging will be conducted by officials of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. Tagged fish will be placed between the Miller's Ferry Dam and the Wilcox – Dallas County line.
- Prize money will be paid to the successful angler within 30 days of passing the polygraph or voice stress test.
- Employees (and their family members) of the Wilcox Area Chamber and individuals (and their family members) releasing the fish are ineligible.
