

Official Derby Rules

- The Jackpot Crappie Derby will begin at 6:00 AM CST, April 17, 2010 and end at 11:59PM CST on May 16, 2010. These are hereby referred to as the "Official Derby Hours." To claim a prize for the catch of a tagged fish, the fish must be caught during Official Derby Hours and presented to Derby officials prior to 11:59 PM CST on May 16, 2010.
- Participant must purchase a \$5 entry ticket prior to catching a tagged fish.
- Tagged fish must be caught on a hook and line. Hoop nets, gill nets, seines, or fish baskets are prohibited means to catch a tagged fish. Fish must be presented alive with tag intact in order to be eligible.
- Participants must comply with all Federal, State, County, and City Laws, Rules and Regulations.
- Officially tagged fish are labeled with readily identifiable tags including the event name, tag number, and phone number to report the catch or find a check station.
- To claim a prize, an angler must first purchase a \$5 entry ticket, catch a tagged fish using hook and line and without the aid of a net larger than a dip net, present the tagged fish alive to tournament officials within Official Derby Hours, and pass a polygraph or voice stress test assuring that all Derby rules stated on this form have been adhered to. Anglers failing to pass a polygraph or voice stress test will be barred from collecting prize money.
- Tagged fish will be placed between the Miller's Ferry Dam and the Wilcox – Dallas County line.
- Prize money will be paid to the successful angler within 30 days of passing the polygraph or voice stress test.
- All local, state, and federal taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner(s).
- Persons releasing the fish and their family members are ineligible.
- Official check stations are as follows: Loftin's Bait Shop, McDonald's Grocery, Roland Cooper State Park, Miller's Ferry Marina, or call 334-525-0462.

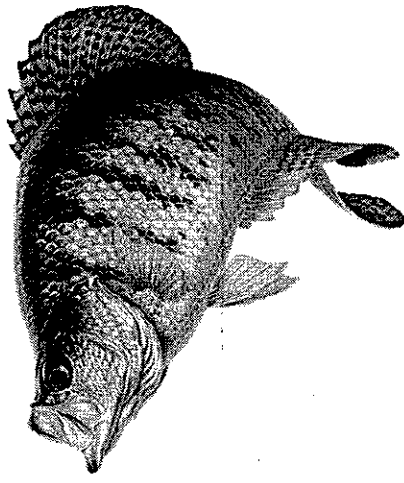

Crappie Tournament

- Big Fish Tournament
- Hourly weigh-ins at 2 locations along the lake. Main location at the Miller's Ferry Marina. Secondary location at Bridgeport Landing. Largest fish per hour (9 / 10 / 11 / 12 / 1 / 2pm) wins \$100, 2nd place wins \$50, and 3rd place wins \$25. Final weigh-in at 3pm at the Miller's Ferry Marina location only.
- Pays top 10 overall places according to participation. 1st place guaranteed \$1000. Largest fish caught by youth angler (under 16) wins \$250.
- \$30 entry fee per adult angler / \$15 for youth under 16. See official rules.

Jackpot Derby

- 200+ crappie will be tagged and released from the Miller's Ferry Dam to the Wilcox/Dallas County line.
- There will be one fish worth a **2010 Chevrolet Silverado** pickup, one fish worth **\$10,000**, three fish worth **\$5,000** each, 25 fish worth \$250 each and remaining fish worth **\$100** each.
- Event begins April 17th and ends May 16th, 2010.
- Daily updates of catches on website.
- \$5 entry fee required per angler. See official rules.

Official Tournament Rules

- Individual competition, practice anytime.
- More than 2 anglers may fish from same boat. Anglers do not have to fish from boat. Live bait may be used.
- Anglers may weigh one crappie per hour for each hourly weigh-in (9/10/11/12/1/2) and one crappie at the final 3pm weigh-in. The heaviest crappie per hourly weigh-in wins \$100, 2nd heaviest wins \$50, 3rd heaviest wins \$25. The heaviest crappie weighed in during the entire tournament wins \$1000 with the top 10 places paid according to participation. The largest crappie caught by a youth angler (under 16) wins \$250 in addition to any other prize money. Hourly payoffs will be made at the final weigh-in. There will be no hourly winners for the 3pm weigh-in.
- Anglers may place only once in overall Top 10 competition.
- Fish weighed in dead will lose .07 pound (1 ounce). Try to bring fish in alive.
- All fish weighed-in will become the property of the Tournament Officials. All live fish will be released.
- Anglers must follow and comply with all Federal, State, County, and City laws.
- Anglers may start fishing on any publicly accessible waters of the Lake Dannelly Reservoir at 6:00AM and continue to fish until 3:00PM. There is no group "blast off."

Tournament Rules (continued)

- Crappie must be caught on pole or rod and hooked in the mouth. No snagging and no yo-yos.
- All anglers must be in line and checked in at the weigh-in site (Miller's Ferry Marina) by 3:00 PM.
- All crappie brought to the scales must have been caught during the contest hours by the angler bringing the fish to the weigh-in site.
- Winners must agree to take and pass a polygraph or voice stress test. Polygraph tests will be final in determining the winners.
- No alcohol or illegal drugs will be permitted during contest hours. Anglers may be disqualified if in the opinion of tournament officials the angler is intoxicated.
- Entry fee is \$30 per adult angler / \$15 youth (under 16). Contact the Chamber office at 334-682-4929 or see our website for ticket locations.
- Late entries will be accepted at the main weigh-in site (Marina) from 6:00AM to 8:00AM the day of the contest. Late entries will pay a \$5 late fee.
